POULTON'S PRINT SHOP LOTTERY IN AID OF THE DANIEL DELICATA MEMORIAL ASSOCIATION.

Thousands of households all over Malta participated in a lottery organized by Mr. Charles Poulton in aid of the Daniel Delicata Memorial Association. Mr. Poulton who owns a printing press, took the initiative of printing and distributing ticket booklets as well as creating a new colourful brochure which illustrates in words and pictures the achievements and future projects of the association which aims to improve the quality of life of sick children who need to use the services and amenities of government health institutions.

A total sum of LM5,668 was raised from this event. This amount was collected to purchase the lino flooring for the Gozitan paediatric ward. This flooring was in bad need of changing as it was fitted thirty years ago. The total cost the association is contributing towards this project is LM10,500. The lino will also include vinyl imprinted characters along the corridors and rooms. These comic characters will complete the overall child-friendly ambience which the DDMA has already implemented when it carried out a total refurbishment in the same ward two years ago.(details on www.danieldelicata.org)
